FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q. What is the difference between Distance learning mode and regular mode?
- A: In regular mode you have the privilege to attend classes regularly but in distance mode there is no such provision. However, the degree obtained from Distance mode is at par with the regular mode.
- Q. What is the admission process?
- A: The admission process in online. You can go to the website of the IDE (Institute of Distance Education) ie, www.rgu.ac.in.
- Q. What is the fee structure?
- A: The details of the fee structure of every programme are given in the prospectus.
- Q. What are the subjects/programmes offered in Under Graduation?
- A. Economics, Education, English, Hindi, History, Political Science, Sociology, Tribal Studies.
- Q. What are the subjects/programmes offered in Post-Graduation?
- A: Economics, Education, English, Hindi, History, Political Science, Sociology.
- Q. Are there any diploma or certificate courses? If yes, what is the duration?
- A: Yes, we have Certificate course in English for Communication (CCEC) and Certificate Course in Fisheries Technology (CCFT). The duration of both the certificate courses is one year.
- Q. Do we get any study materials from the institute?
- A: Yes, you will get the SLM (Self Learning Material) along with assignment response sheet from the institution or the study centres at the time of admission.
- Q. Can we use other study materials in lieu of SLM provided by the institution?
- A: Yes, but the materials should be from relevant source.
- Q. Is it mandatory to attend the contact and counselling programme?
- A: It is mandatory because during contact and counselling programme whole syllabus is discussed in detail and also enhances the learning process.
- Q. What is the importance of assignment? Is it compulsory to submit assignments?
- A: Assignments are compulsory as the examination process includes both assignment and term end exam. In order to qualify for sitting in term end examination, submission of assignment is compulsory as marks scored in assignment is accredited in final mark sheet.
- Q. Can we apply for CBSE NET being a student of IDE?
- A: Yes, as the degrees obtain from IDE is at par with regular mode. However, the qualifying percentage is 50% for ST and 55% for General candidates.
- Q. Are we eligible to apply for further studies like MPhil and Ph.D.?
- A: Yes.

Q. Is Migration Certificate mandatory for admission?

A: Yes, it is mandatory to submit the original Migration Certificate for the students from the colleges/universities outside the state and original Registration Card for the students within the state.

Q. Does the institute issue bonafide certificate?

A: Yes.

Q. Does the institute issue registration card?

A: Yes.
